BACKGROUND

Immunization is one of the most cost-effective interventions that prevents needless suffering through sickness, disability and death. Its benefits are not restricted to improvement in health and life expectancy; it also has social and economic impact at both community and national levels.

Cold Chain and Vaccine Management is a key driver of the immunization program. It has a significant impact upon vaccine availability, safety and potency, which are key to ensuring that beneficiaries have confidence in the program, thereby encouraging the uptake of immunization and enhancing the coverage of Fully Immunized Children (FIC).

The Training on Vaccine & Cold Chain Management (T-VaCC) is conceptualized as skill multiplier for immunization program managers to better plan and manage their vaccine cold chain systems.

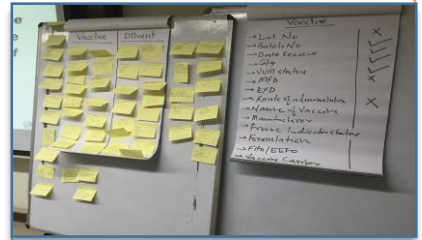


OBJECTIVES

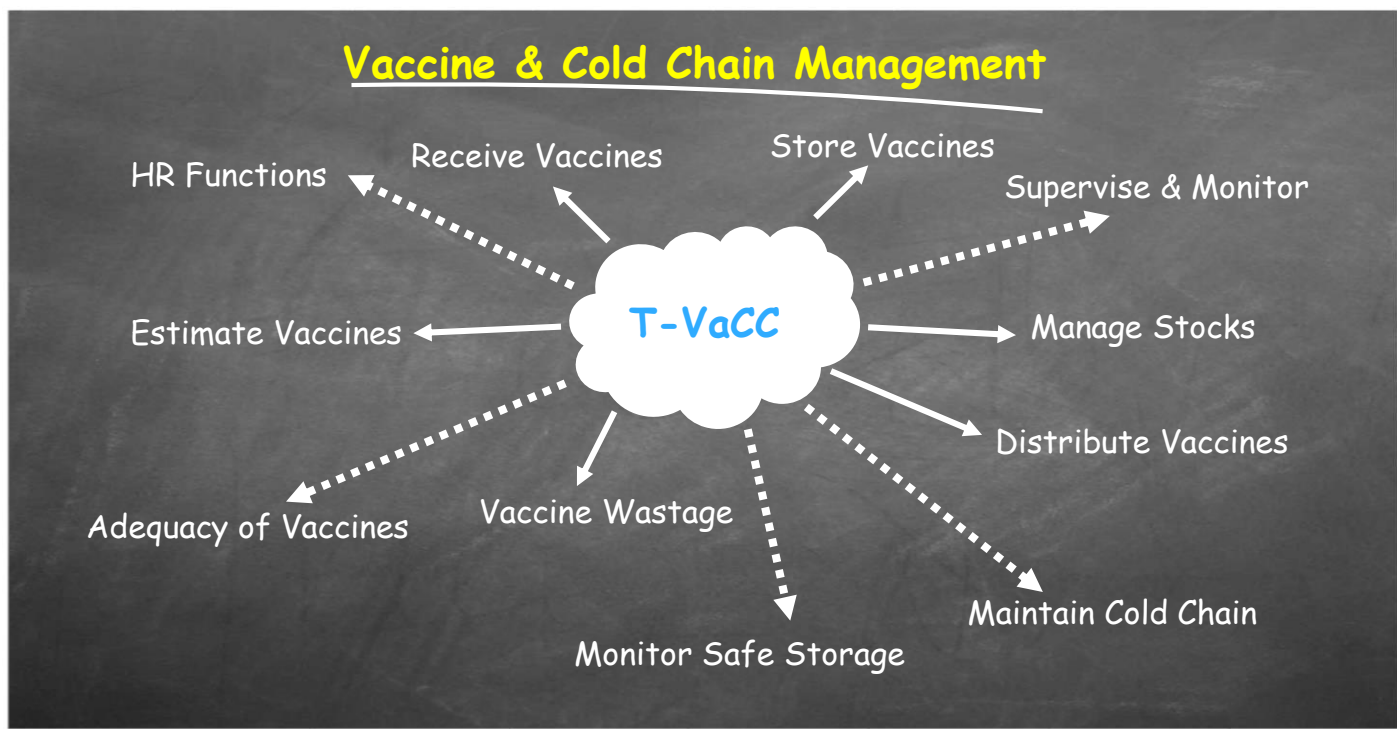
The T-VaCC seeks to strengthen the skills of immunization program managers in effective planning, implementation and supervision of the vaccine cold chain system.
