

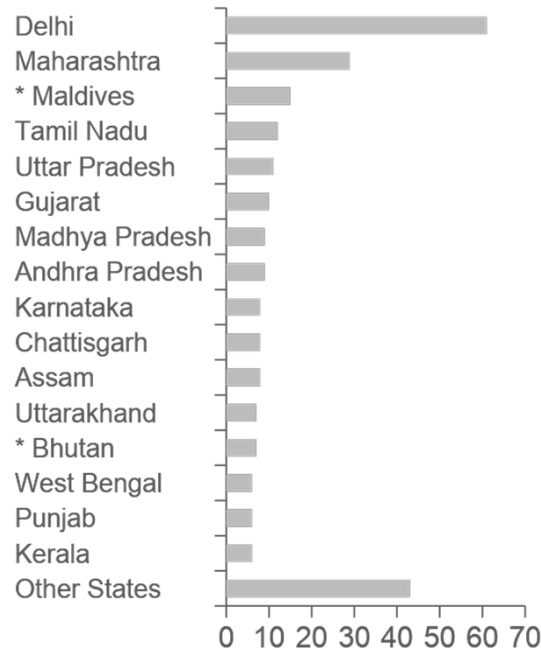


About us

Introduction

Hospitals play a pivotal role in health care delivery system of our nation. Hospital administrators and managers ensure smooth and unrestricted delivery of healthcare services within their respective organisations. It has been increasingly realised that the training in managerial concepts and skills is lacking in the medical curriculum of our nation. As a consequence, a competence deficit develops when medical professionals assume administrative posts. This may severely affect the quality of care delivered through our hospitals. India has one of the largest public sector healthcare delivery system in the world. It has undergone extensive systematic convergence of resources and infrastructure under the aegis of National Health Mission. This has led to a significant bearing on hospital administrators with emergence of new complex problems at the ground level. The NIHFW offers the opportunity to hospitals and institutions of Centre, States, Army, Paramilitary, ESIC, Indian Railways and other Public and private setups to fill the knowledge gap of their managerial workforce i.e. Directors, Medical Superintendents, Senior Medical Officers, etc. and help them to optimise operations and improve the efficiency of their respective institutions within existing constraints.

Rationale

Healthcare leaders must have expertise in leadership management, healthcare finance, and human resource management in order to maintain excellence in service and patient care. This course aims to ensure that healthcare leaders have access to the leading practices in complex organizational management and healthcare leadership.

Objectives

At the end of the course, the participants will be able to:

- ❖ Describe clearly the basic concepts of management and hospital administration
- ❖ Describe the efficient management of human, financial and physical resources
- ❖ Understand and utilise the concepts of Patient safety, Quality care, Health Management Information Systems (HIMS), Legal aspects, etc.
- ❖ Plan and manage various hospital services like OPD, IPD, ICU, OT, Lab, Blood Bank, CSSD, Pharmacy, Laundry, etc.

Participants will learn with the aid of Multimedia presentations, Group exercises. Ample opportunity will be provided to interact with expert faculties from premier institutes and organisations like AIIMS, SH-VMMC, PGIMER-RMLH, Academy of Hospital Administrators, etc.
