Introduction

The Department of Statistics and Demography has been conducting the training programme on Demographic and Statistics methods for the health professionals including faculty of medical colleges. Over the years the feedback given by them indicates that there is a need for conducting a training programme with a special focus on statistical methods and analysis by using standard statistical software such as Epi-info/STATA/SPSS etc. All the software except Epi-info is commercial and chargeable. The software Epi-info is available freely and useful for basic statistical analysis, not for advance level analysis. The tools of the Epi-info or any free software are not user friendly; require the knowledge of Microsoft access for data management. The Statistical software Packages for Social Sciences (SPSS) is user friendly and vastly used by academicians, researchers and students to analyse the data of research studies/Surveys/Evaluations etc. Therefore, training course on data analysis using standard Statistical Packages for Health and Demographic research is being organised for professionals engaged in research and analysis of health and demographic studies.

General Objective

To orient the participants on data analysis and develop their skills in use of statistical software for health and demographic research.

Specific Objectives

At the end of the training course, the participants would be able to:

- 1. To prepare the coding plan and create data set
- 2. To describe the nature of variables
- 3. To describe the applications of the statistical o software in data analysis o

Course Contents

The course intends to cover topics such as:-

- Introduction of data analysis
- Basic features of statistical software
- Preparation of Data set using software, measurement scale of variables
- o Data management
- Data analysis
- Testing of hypothesis
- Correlation and regression analysis

Methodology

The methodology of the course will comprise of:

- participatory discussion

- o Demonstrations
- Participants Presentation
- Problem centered and practical exercises
- Hands-on training and problem solving (exercises and data analysis using various software).
